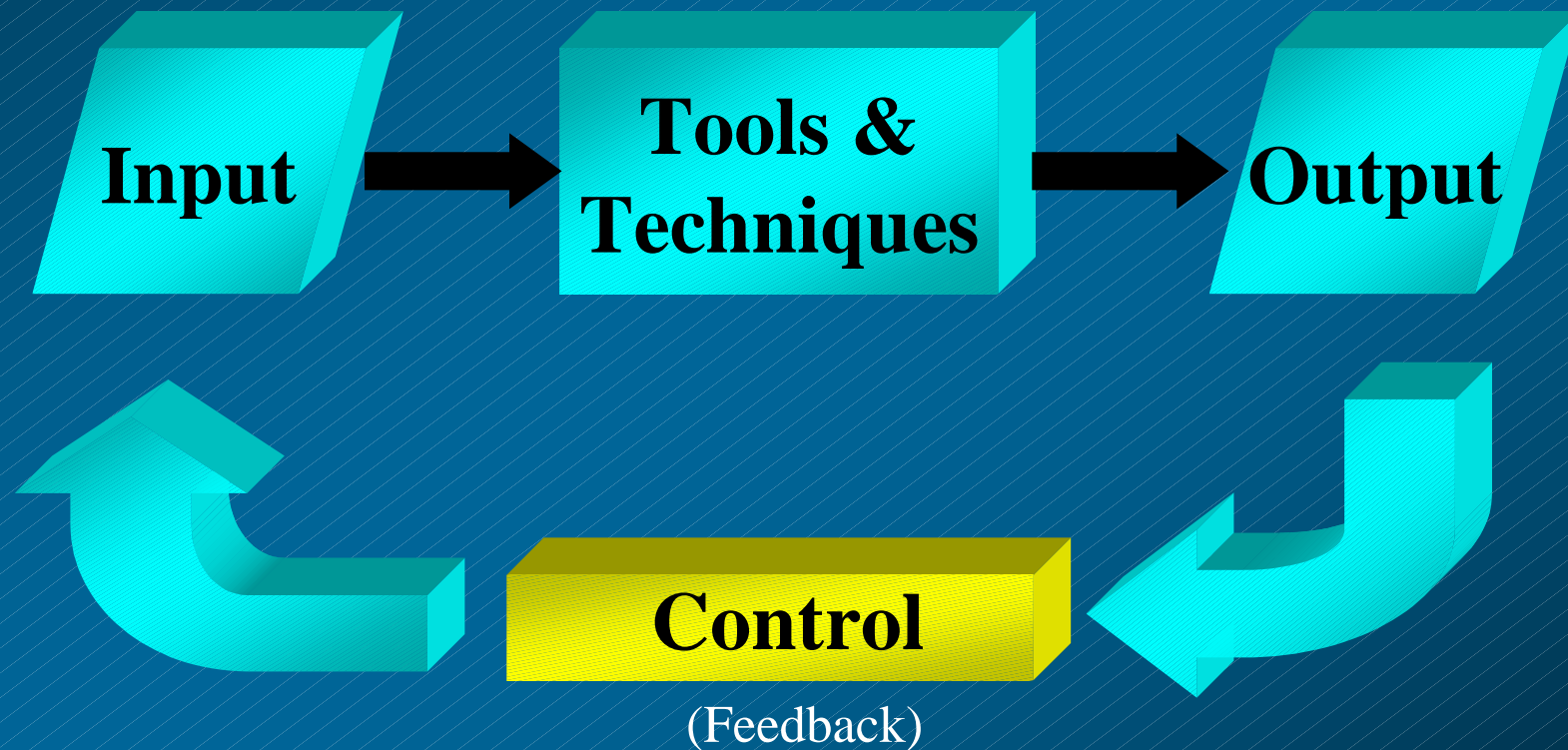

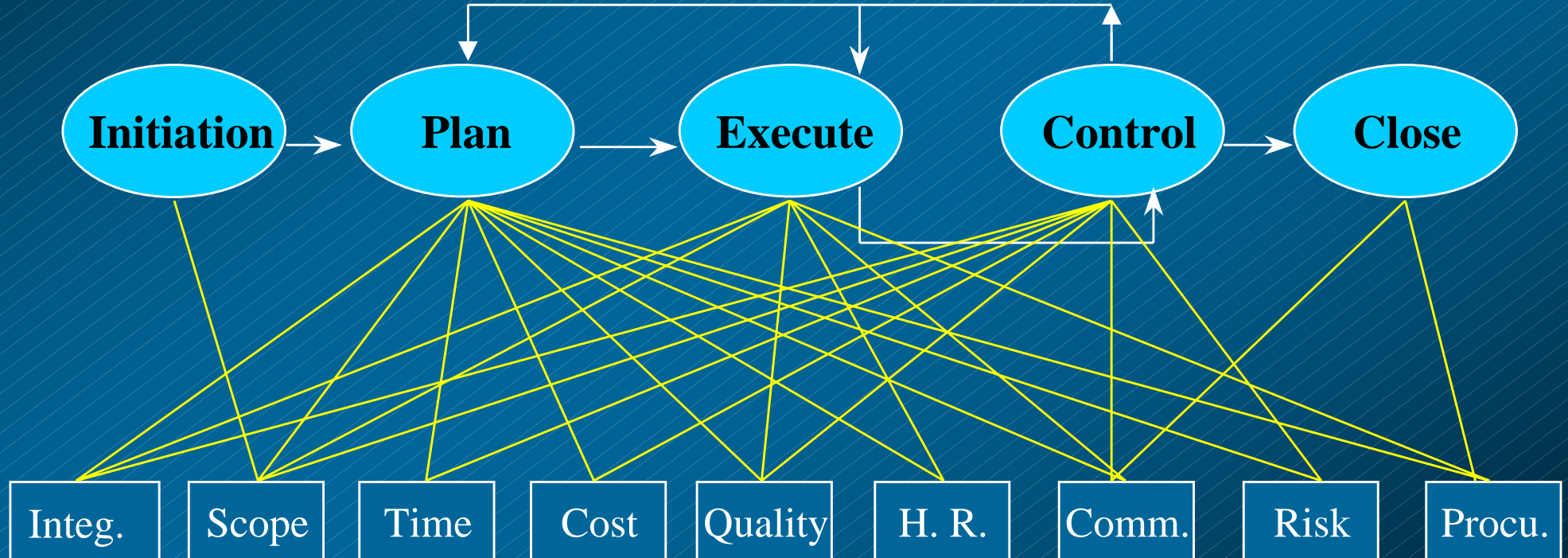

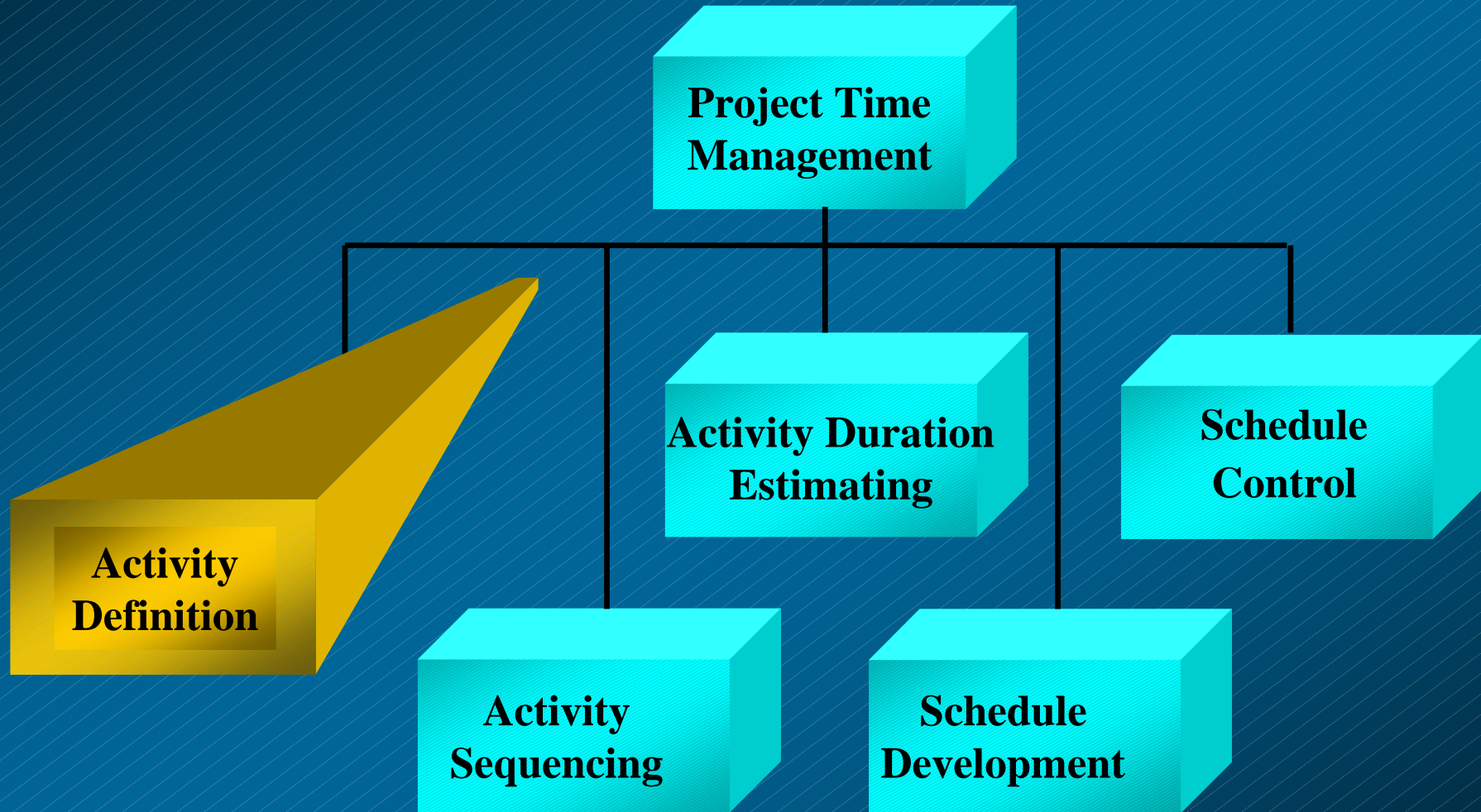


Defining Critical Path

The critical path is the path through the activities required to complete the project that takes the longest time. The durations of these activities determine the minimum time to complete the project and delays of these activities will delay the project.

One should not conclude that activities not on the path are not essential to the project, just that the duration of the activity is not as “critical” to the timely completion as activities on the critical path.
